Books:

The following texts **may** be studied throughout the year (**this is subject to change**): *The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian*, *Be True to Your School*, *Fallen Angels*, *Night*, *Catcher in the Rye*, and *The College Writer*. Related readings will also be included in each unit.
